

Degree Exam Processes of the International Master Program in Asia-Pacific Affairs

Select an Advising Professor for Research Thesis

Required Document: “Research Thesis Advising Professor Application Form”

Deadline: During the second semester of the freshmen year (before July 31)

Application for Thesis Proposal

Required Document: “Thesis Proposal Application Form” (at least include the thesis topic, literature review, research method, thesis structure, and references)

Deadline: Prior to November 30 during the first semester and prior to April 30 during the second semester.

Application for Changing the Advising Professor or Thesis Topic

Required Document: “Thesis Topic and Advisor Change Application Form”

3 months after the “Thesis Proposal” has been approved

Application for Thesis Oral Defense

Required Documents: “Master’s Thesis Oral Defense Application Form”

Deadline: No later than two weeks prior to the oral defense.

Pass

A student shall receive an average grade of B⁻ in his/her Master’s degree thesis in order to pass and receive the Master’s degree in Asia-Pacific Affairs.

Failed

Those who failed the degree exam and whose term of study has not yet expired may take a re-exam in the following semester or school year. Re-exam shall be taken only once, and those who failed the re-exam shall be discontinued in accordance with the provisions provided by the school.
